- 1. The name of the school is St James's CE Primary School
- 2. The school is a voluntary aided school
- 3. The name of the governing body is "The governing body of St James's CE Primary School"
- 4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - a. 2 Parent governors;
 - b. 1 Local Authority governor;
 - c. 1 Staff governor;
 - d. 1 Headteacher;
 - e. 1 Co-opted governor;
 - f. 8 Foundation governors.
- 5. Total number of governors 14.
- 6. The Board of Education of the Diocese of Worcester shall appoint 4 Foundation governors.
- 7. The Parochial Church Council of the Parish of Wollaston shall appoint 3 Foundation governors.
- 8. a. the holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio:
 - The Principal Officiating Minister of the Parish of Wollaston, St James.
 - b. The Archdeacon of Dudley shall appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office name in (a) above, in the event that the ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which a governorship exists, or has been removed from office under regulation 21 (1) of the Regulations.

- 9. The Archdeacon of Dudley shall be entitled to remove of any ex officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
- 10. Ethos Statement
